



Yarn: 2 skeins Noro silk garden (same colorway or different, but contrast is good. Either way, designate one skein A and the other B.)

Needles: size 10 1/2

Gauge: approximately 20 sts and 16 rows per 4 inches of feather & fan pattern after blocking will achieve about a six foot scarf. Go for a lacey look that you prefer, and remember that the scarf will stretch when blocked.

Pattern:

CO 32 sts loosely with A.

Row 1 (RS): With A, knit across.

Row 2: P.

Row 3: With B, knit 1, \*k2tog 5 times, [k1, yo] 10 times, k2tog 5 times\*, repeat from \*to \* to last st, k1.

Row 4: K.



Repeat these four rows until scarf is desired length and/or yarn runs out. BO loosely. Ends will not match—the CO end will be convex and the BO end will be concave. Soak and block to desired size.
